Physical Development:

- Continue to develop letter formation and handwriting skills
- Combine different movements with ease and fluency
- Progress towards a more fluent style of moving, with developing control and grace

Communication and Language

- Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction
- Offer explanations as to why things might happen.
- Express ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences.
- Use new vocabulary in different contexts.

Maths:

- Building number and counting patterns beyond 10.
- Spatial reasoning: match, rotate manipulate. Compose, decompose.
- Adding more: first, then and now.

Holly Class 2025/26 Summer 1

This half term in Holly Class we will be looking at mini beasts. Our stories in Literacy will inspire us to explore a variety of minibeasts including: butterflies, frogs and snails. We will explore their lifecycle, habitat and what we can do to look after them.

Understanding the World:

- Know what a lifecycle is and that all living things go through a lifecycle
- Know why minibeasts are important and say some of their roles in the environment.
- Know what a habitat is and the habitat of some minibeasts.

Expressive arts and design:

- Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses
- Invent, adapt and recount narratives and stories with peers and their teacher.
- Develop their own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them.

Literacy:

- Form lower case and capital letters correctly.
- Spell words by identifying sounds, then writing the sounds with letters.
- Retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently learned vocabulary.
- Anticipate key events in stories.

Core texts:

- My Butterfly Bouquet
- Winnie the Pooh Helps the Bees
- Tad

Phonics:

Phase 3 sounds- ai ee igh oa o oar or ur ow oi ear air er, double consonants and longer words

Tricky words: said, so, have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out, today

Personal, Social, Emotional:

- Explain the reasons for rules
- Show understanding of their own feelings and those of others and begin to regulate their behaviour accordingly
